Dear Sir,

In accordance with:

1. Chapter 1 Section 2.3.3 of the Rules for the Manufacture, Testing and Certification of Materials dated July 2019, which state: *"All mechanical tests required by these Rules are to be witnessed. The surveyor may allow part of this task to be carried out by a member of the works staff by prior written agreement"*; and
2. Part B, Materials, Ch.1, Sect 1.4.8 of Rulefinder Version 9.24 (Lloyd's Register Marine Survey Procedures Manual), dated July 2015, which states: *"It is intended that, generally, all mechanical tests should be witnessed by the Surveyor, but, where circumstances arise to make this impracticable, the Surveyor may, at his personal discretion, entrust part of this duty to a reliable member of the works staff; this permission should be given in writing"*.
3. Part 5, Lloyd's Register Rules and Regulations - Rules and Regulations for the Classification of Ships, July 2017, - Main and Auxiliary Machinery - General Requirements for the Design and Construction of Machinery - General 1.2 Survey for classification Sc. 1.2.1, which states: *"The Surveyors are to examine and test the materials and workmanship from the commencement of work until the final test of the machinery under full power working conditions. Any defects, etc., are to be indicated as early as possible. On completion, the Surveyors will submit a report and if this is found to be satisfactory by the Committee a certificate will be granted and an appropriate notation will be assigned in accordance with Pt 1, Ch 2."*

In view that the mechanical tests will be carried out at Sider Test S.r.l. Laboratory at Castel San Giovanni (PC), which is a Recognized Laboratory (Accredia N° 0864)

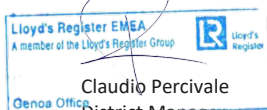
LR EMEA hereby grants Mr. Paolo Biagini responsible authority for mechanical tests arising from the Contract, which it is impracticable for Lloyd's Register EMEA to witness personally.

If the Laboratory mentioned above will be replaced with another one, Messrs Biagini Piero & C will advise Lloyd's Register immediately in order to revise new procedure and contract Terms accordingly; otherwise this contract will be withdrawn.

This Side Letter shall remain in force from the date set out above until the earlier of: (i) a change in the Lloyd's Register Rules for the Manufacture, Testing and Certification of Materials dated July 2019, which invalidates the contents of this Side Letter; or (ii) the termination of the Contract.
